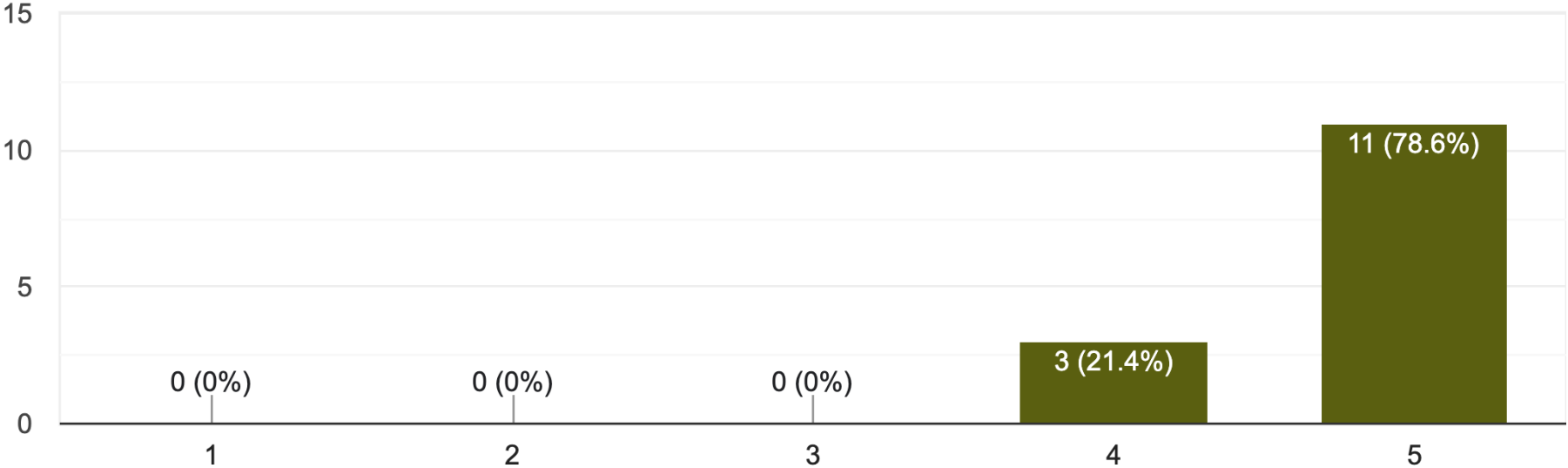

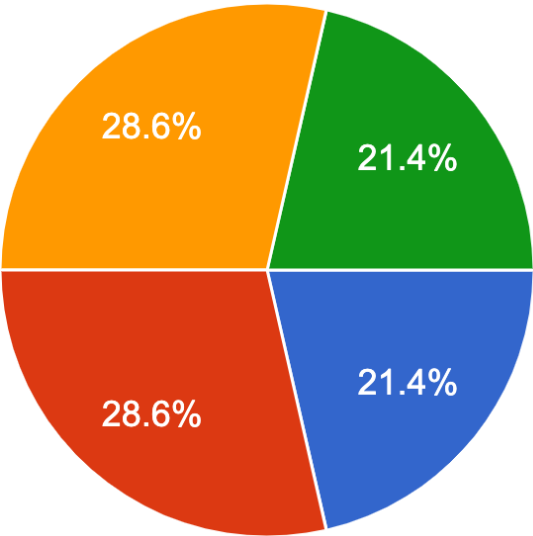
### How satisfied were you with the event?

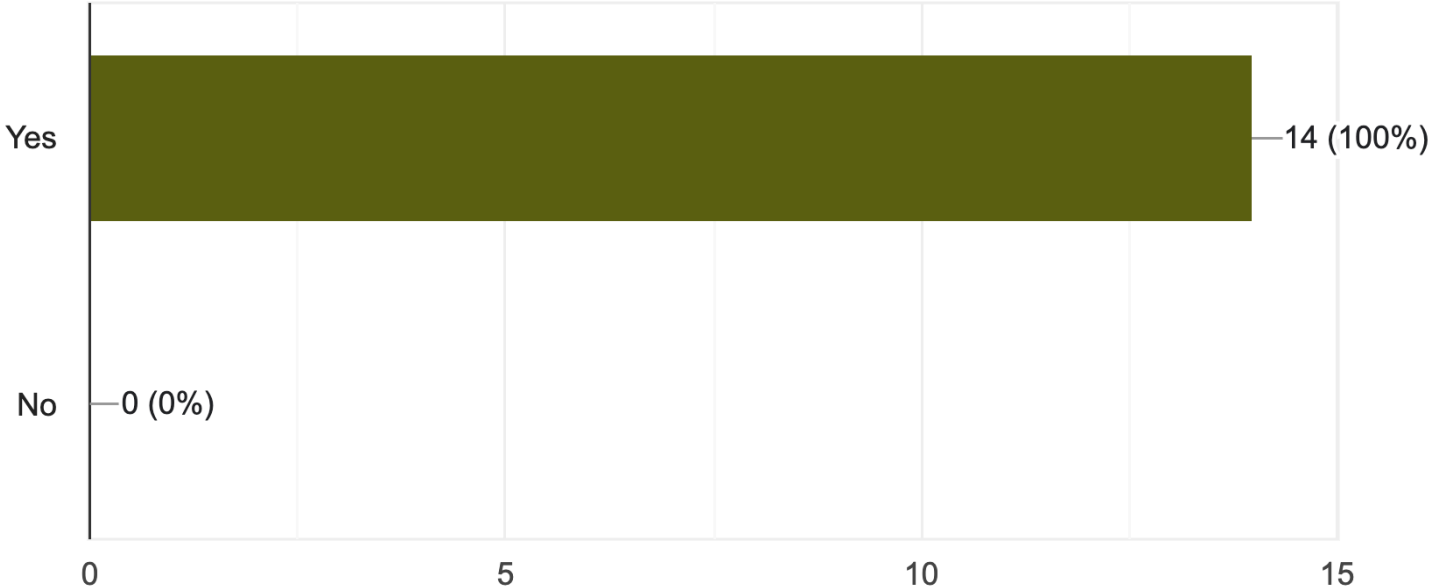

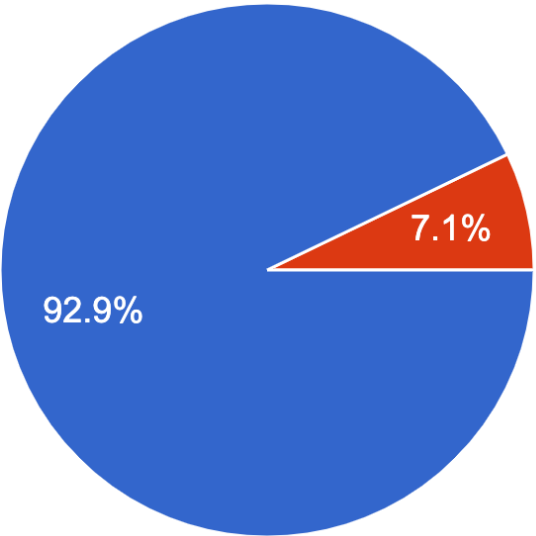
